Out of a support group from 1997, the *Berliner Leberring e.V.* was founded. Meanwhile it has become a counseling center for all persons affected from hepatitis. Since 2002, the counseling center is located on the grounds of the Charité-Campus Benjamin Franklin. The association celebrated its 10th club anniversary in 2007.

We help liver patients

who are just going through the therapy and / or who are hospitalized.

We train our team of consultants

on a regular basis and set out additional trainings for our employees.
We all work voluntarily.

We guide our discussion groups

with its own consultant. The meetings take place in our group room.

We set up events

for affected and interested people, offer seminars, we are invited by various institutions to give lectures on hepatitis and we bring diverse informational material.

We demand

that the prevailing opinion in the public is eliminated that a liver patient must be an alcoholic.

Working in the liver clinic

For several years we have offered our services in the liver clinic of the Charité-Campus Benjamin Franklin to support the clinical treatment of patients and physicians. As a result, there is still a very close collaboration with the clinic doctors.
